


2021 CHALLENGE 10 UFO'S N 11 MONTHS

September BOM

End of summer, start of school, cooler weather? I'm sitting in my cooler Ojai house (no air conditioning, but lots of oak trees and breezes!) September and October Block of the Month surprises are on their way!

"Tiny Houses" is the September BOM. It's a traditional log cabin, just a smaller size. So, you get to make four of the same smaller block, then sew them all together. There's some room for play here — how about making each block in a different colorway and then sewing them together? Or, you could play with the layout, which is one of the fun ways to vary the final look.



October BOM

The October BOM is called "Bats in the Attic", just in time for Halloween. This pattern has some angles, but with the techniques of foundation paper piecing you'll be fine!

Still a little frustrated with FPP? Here's another video you might like, by <u>Surgaridoo</u>. It's about cutting fabrics for foundation paper piecing, in case that's what frustrates you. I've had several members tell me it's a good video (it was previously posted with the August block instructions).

Our September and October BOM will be posted on the CQA website around the first day of each month. You'll also receive an email notifying you when the patterns are posted and ready for printing.

Orange Dot Quilts was created in 2015 by me, Dora Cary, a Romanian-born engineer and designer who moved to the United States in 2001, discovered quilting in 2006, made my first quilt and became an American citizen in 2008, and wrote my first quilt pattern in 2013.

Now I have more than 20 quilt and bag patterns and even more patterns are waiting to be created. I have several notebooks filled with ideas and sketches waiting to be turned into quilts, bags, or something else altogether.

Fearless Free Motion Quilting

In class you will learn:

- how to prepare your sewing machine for free motion quilting;
- how to make a quilt sandwich so that you will quilt with less effort;
- how to quilt without basting using Dora's No Baste Method;
- a variety of quilting designs, both traditional and modern style;
- how to address issues about technique, needles, machine speed, thread tension, various quilting/darning feet (open or closed toe, transparent or not, plastic or metal, stitch regulators and more);
- how to free motion quilt with confidence on your home sewing machine.


