

September House – 2018

Supply List:

Background Fabric – enough to make a 12" x 12" block finished

Scraps for house, roof, chimney, windows, tree and tree trunk



Pre-cut your scraps into the following sizes:

House: 2 – 8 ½ x 2" rectangle

2 – 2 ½ x 1 ¼" rectangle

3 – 1 ½ x 5 ¼" rectangle

Windows:

4 – 2 ½" squares

Roof and Chimneys:

1 – 8 ½ x 2" rectangle

2 – 2" x 2 +5/8" rectangle

Tree:

1 – 4 ½ x 2 ½ " rectangle

5 – 4 ½ x 1 ½ " rectangle

Background:

10 – 1 ½" squares

1 – 1 ½ x 8 ½ " rectangle

2 – 2" squares

2 – 2" x 2 +5/8" rectangle

1 – 2 +5/8 x 2 +3/8 rec.

2 – 2 ¼ x 5 ½" rec.

2 – 2 ½" squares

Tree Trunk

1 – 1 ¼ x 5 ½" rectangle

Construction:

Tree: Using the $4\frac{1}{2}$ "x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " tree fabric and two background fabric $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Draw a line from corner to corner on the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Place the marked squares right sides together over the tree fabric. Sew, trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press.

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of $10\frac{1}{2}$ " background squares. Layer marked squares rst on the five $4\frac{1}{2}$ x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " on each end of the rectangle. Sew, trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press.

Tree Trunk:

Join two - $1\frac{1}{2}$ x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " background fabric with $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " tree trunk fabric. Sew, trim and press.

Assemble the tree as shown in **diagram 1**.

Chimney, Roof and Windows:

Join two – 2 " x $2\frac{5}{8}$ " background, two – 2 " x $2\frac{5}{8}$ chimneys and one $2\frac{5}{8}$ " x $2\frac{3}{8}$ " background as shown in **diagram 2**.

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of two 2 " background squares. Layer a 2 " square rst on one $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 " roof rectangle as shown in **diagram 3**. Sew on diagonal line. Repeat for opposite corner. Trim and press.

Assemble windows by joining four windows to the house as shown in **diagram 4**.

Assemble house to tree as shown in **diagram 5**.
