

## **Class requirements for Arabesque**

*(finished quilt size: 52" x 52")*

### ***Tools of the trade:***

- sewing machine, extra needles, thread, bobbins, scissors
- Cutting board, rulers and rotary cutter
- iron and ironing board

### ***Special class related requirements:***

- scissors for cutting paper or a dull blade rotary cutter to use for cutting paper
- Scotch tape
- "add a quarter" ruler

### ***Fabric:***

- 1 1/2 yards each of light, medium light, dark, and medium dark solids for a total of 6 yards.

### ***Pattern:***

- Arabesque with FPP templates (to follow and use in class and take home to finish the quilt). The patterns will be available for purchase before the class. One Arabesque pattern with all the foundations paper piecing sheets included is \$20. Additional packs of ONLY foundations paper piecing sheets are \$10 each.

### **HOMEWORK:**

Tape together and cut out all the pieces of the paper template before coming to class. It will save time in class and allow you to finish more of the actual sewing part.

### **In this workshop you will learn:**

- the foundation paper piecing technique;
- how to easily manage complex intersections of seams with the most precision;
- how to bind inner and outer corners beautifully.
