

March House 2019 - 6" - Pinwheels



Note: Refer to the "General Instructions" for January/February

Houses. The basic house is the same only the 6" block will change.

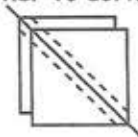
BLOCK CONSTRUCTION:

This block is just 9 little pinwheels. I made a set of 3 alike, another set of 4, and a final set of 2. Again, I'll remind you to press your seams open. This will help with matching your points and will keep your block less bulky for your quilter!

For each of your 9 pinwheels, cut:

4 - 1 7/8" squares (2 of one color, and 2 of another color)

Place face-to-face and cut through both fabrics corner to corner.

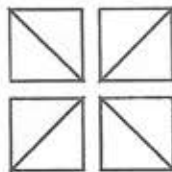


Sew a 1/4" seam diagonally on both triangles.

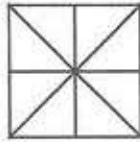


Press open and trim the ears to make two half-square triangle units. Your 4 1 7/8" squares will yield 4 half square triangle units.

Arrange them pinwheel fashion.



Sew the top two together and the bottom two together. Sew the 2 strips together to make your pinwheel.



After all nine pinwheels are complete, you're ready to sew them together. Arrange them in 3 rows of 3 blocks. Sew your rows together to make your block.
