

OMBRE BARGELLO

This is a wonderful two fabric bargello quilt. Your main fabric will be an Ombre fabric. The ombre fabrics can vary. Most fabrics will be darker on the salvage and get lighter as you go toward the center. Another option that you may find will have the colors graduate from light to dark across the width of the fabric. Your secondary fabric or focus fabric will be used as the inset as well as for the borders and binding. This fabric can be anything that your like. It can blend with your ombre or it can be a high contrast fabric. If you need some ideas, check out Pinterest. This quilt is made by using the length of the fabric and both selvage edges of the ombre will be touching the focus fabric.

Supply List:

Pattern - "Two Fabric Bargello" by Susie Weaver I will have this pattern available for purchase @ \$10.00

1 ¾ yards of Ombre

1 ¾ yards of a Focus print

6 x 24 inch ruler

4 x 8 inch ruler

Tape measure

Larger rotary cutting mat a 23 x 18 works best

Rotary cutter

Basic quilting supplies

Sewing machine in good working order

Pencil

Couple of safety pins

Before class please press your fabric. If you are using a K. Fassett fabric or any other lighter weight fabric for your focus fabric, please spray stretch it.

Remove the salvage edges from both sides of the ombre fabric and the salvage from one side of your focus fabric.
