Camarillo Quilters Association General Membership Meeting Minutes Tuesday, May 14, 2019

CALL TO ORDER – The May 2019, General Membership Meeting of the Camarillo Quilters Association was called to order by President Jonal Beck on Tuesday, May 14, 2019, at 9:32 a.m., in the Pleasant Valley Community Center at 1605 E. Burnley Dr., Camarillo, CA 93010. Secretary Joyce Turner was present.

WELCOME – President Jonal Beck called the meeting to order and welcomed those present.

ANNOUNCEMENTS -

PRESIDENT - Jonal Beck referred members to the bulletin board for valuable information such as business cards, items for sale including two sewing/embroidery machines, other guild meetings, and quilt shows. Jonal announced May birthdays and welcomed guests, including a guest from the Ventura Modern Quilt Guild, Kim Halamicek, selling tickets to a progressive brunch and quilt in home tour on Jun. 22, 2019. Jonal announced the membership drive is ongoing and if signing up for the Camarillo Quilters Association today, you get a free fat quarter. Jonal announced this was her last meeting as President. Jonal presented the outgoing Board members with gifts.

VICE PRESIDENT – Barbara Witman presented the incoming 2019-2020 Board members.

TREASURERS REPORT – Judy Hively provided the following account balances for the end of April 2019: checking account \$23,519.75; savings account \$33,578.92; and Certificate of Deposit \$18,752.72.

WORKSHOPS – Joey Strait announced tomorrow's workshop is "Charm by Squares" with Pam Hadfield with seats still available. Joey reported June's workshop is the Eleanor Burns log cabin quilt technique with Lorraine Tennyson and that the book and ruler for the workshop are available at a discount.

COMFORT GIVERS – Jenny Carr Kenney presented three quilts made by Friendship Stars mini group that were being donated to Comfort Givers. Jenny requested members pick up quilt kits at the Comfort Givers table. Jenny announced we received 38 quilts today, with one member donating 33 quilts, and that next month is the quilt give away.

TRAVEL – Elli Throckmorton announced the Poinsettia Pavilion retreat was a success and that another one is being planned for Nov. 4-6, 2019, with tickets going on sale in July 2019.

BLOCK OF THE MONTH (BOM) – Kathy Adams announced she enjoyed her tenure as the BOM Chair and introduced the new BOM Chair person, Jonette Duchai. Kathy reported next years theme is stars, using all techniques. Kathy announced there were 60 participants this year

and commended the five people that consistently participated and presented each with a gift. Kathy and Jonette announced today's winner of the April 2019 blocks.

QUILT SHOW 2020 – Thelma Atkinson announced the next meeting for the April 2020 quilt show is Jun. 3, 2019, at the Dudley House, and for committee members to please attend. Thelma reported "Ruby Jubilee" quilt entries could be turned in at the July 2019 meeting. Thelma announced instructions on how to package the quilt are available on the quilt show table. Linda Stone reported the Quilt Show 2020 quilt challenge requirements are red and white solids, prints, or tone on tones fabrics only, outside dimensions of 72" and 100", finished edges, any quilt pattern, a 4" sleeve at the top of the quilt, and must have a label on it. Linda announced the challenge quilts were due at the March 2020 meeting.

SHOW AND TELL – Twenty-two members presented thirty two quilts, one sham, two repaired hand made sampler quilts, and several fabric art post cards. Two of the quilts were from a Dora Cary "Only One" pattern made by Barbara Witman who announced she would be teaching a class on how to make the quilts on Jul. 15 and 22, 2019, at Quilty Pleasures in Simi Valley.

MISCELLANEOUS – Jan Hunter announced there would be a "Seasonal Treasures" booth at the 2020 Quilt Show and to please donate "small-ish" seasonal quilted items such as table runners, candle mats, and wall hanging to be sold at the booth as a major guild fund raiser. Margaret Booker thanked all for their dog bed fabric donations and reported future dog bed making sessions would be announced. Sharon Norbutas announced that member calendars are on sale and that she has entry forms for Quilt Expo. Kim Halamicek from Ventura Modern Quilt Guild announced she was selling tickets at \$20 each for a progressive brunch at five guild members homes who would display modern quilts throughout their homes, and that if you visited all five homes, you could be entered for a grand prize basket.

SPEAKER – Maribeth Benedict introduced guest speaker Pam Hadfield.
