

June 2022 - Disappearing 4-Patch

Cutting sizes given are a little oversized. This allows you to trim / square up block at the end. Also, you are free to decide how many colors to use. I've included some examples of finished blocks in each option below. Instructions will use the 2-color option.

2 fabrics



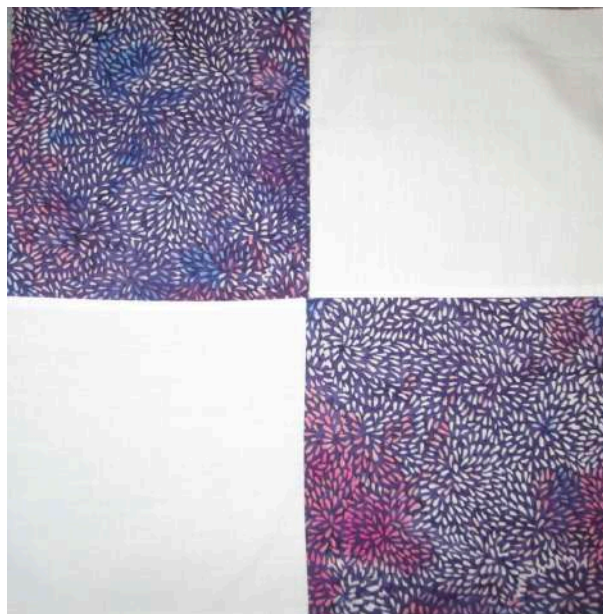
3 fabrics



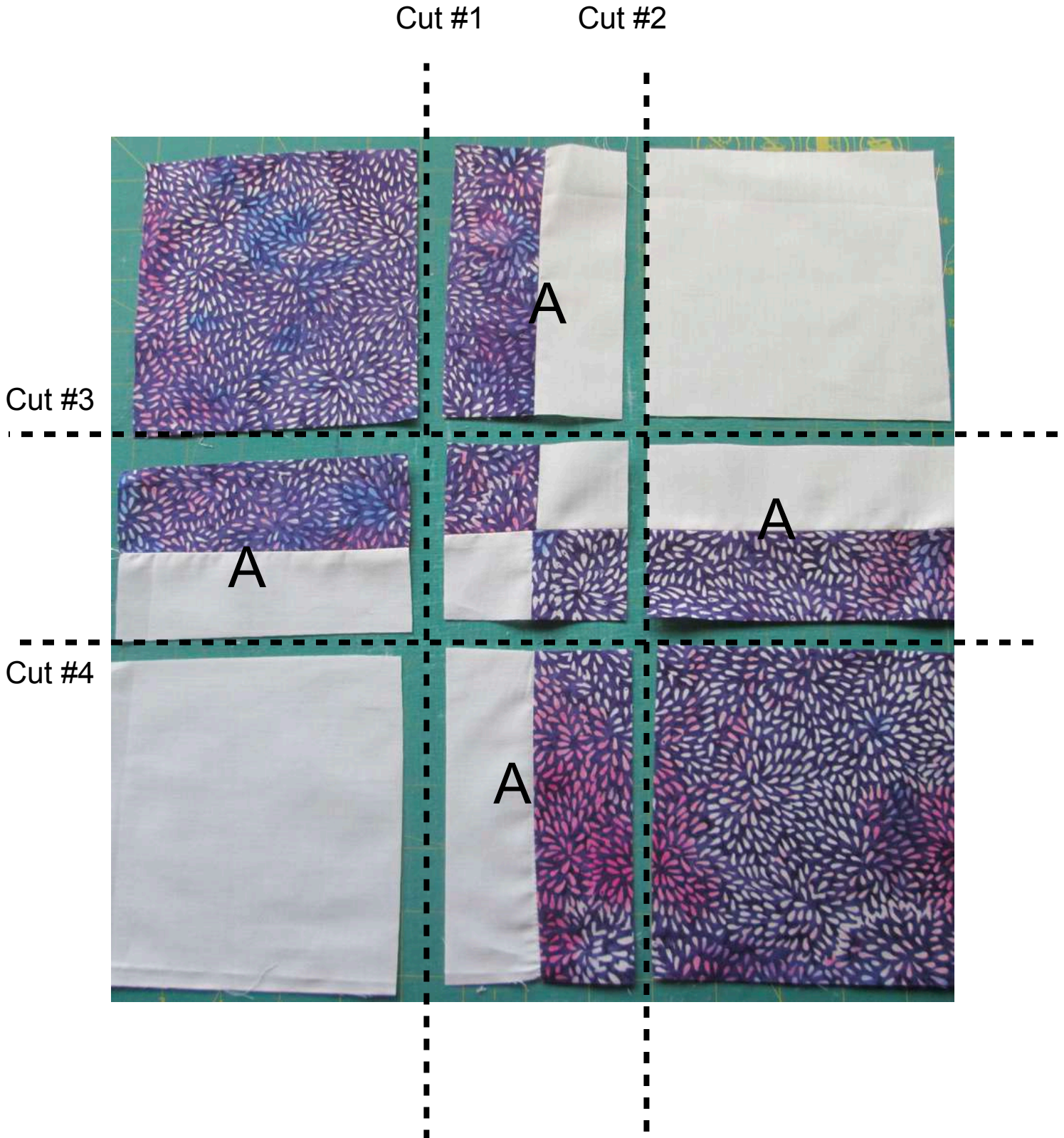
4 fabrics



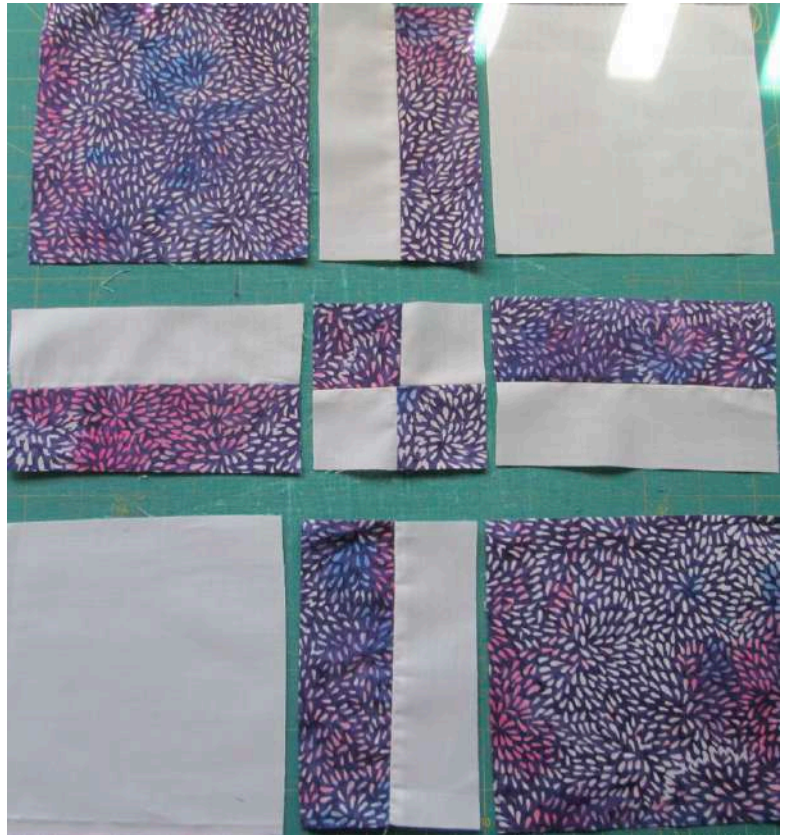
1. Cut out 4 squares, 7.5 inches each.
2. Sew squares into a 4-Patch Unit. Press flat.



- 3, Measure 1.5 inches from CENTER SEAM of block for each cut.
Cut as shown by dotted lines. You will have 9 sections.
The center 4-patch will measure 3" square.
The side "A" rectangle units will measure 3" wide



4. Rearrange 9 sections as shown.
5. Assemble pieces as with a 9-patch block. Sew pieces together into rows, nesting seams where possible. Then sew rows together.



6. Press flat. Trim / square block to 12.5 inches. And that's it !
