

“Stitching In Harmony” Quilt Show Guidelines

General Quilt Entries

- Each quilt should include a **label attached to the backside** with the name of the maker. This is necessary to make sure quilts are not lost and easily identify the quilt for display. The label can be sewed on or safety pinned to the quilt.
- Each quilt should be submitted on a single-entry form and delivered in a single bag; cloth bags are preferable but not required; your name must be clearly visible on the outside of the bag.
- Quilts of all sizes will be accepted; larger quilts may be folded to accommodate displays.
- Quilts should be delivered to the April 9, 2024 CQA meeting.

Personal Statement

Each quilt entered should include a **brief 50-word Personal Statement** with your name, the title of your quilt and some reference to music...a song, a concert, any special inspiration for the quilt you are submitting for this show. Consider including details of techniques, pattern choices or fabric selections. Personal statements will be printed on a 4 x 6 inch show label and displayed with your quilt. Personal statements may be emailed in advance to Cheryl Collart (Cheryl.collart@gmail.com) with the subject line: CQA PS and YOUR NAME. You may also attach your personal statement to the entry form.

CQA Workshop quilts

Quilts submitted should have begun with a CQA Workshop and have been finished recently. These quilts don't need musical inspirations as their themes, but definitely should include the **personal statement** about what you learned and why you participated in the workshop. Workshop quilts will be collected and coordinated by Vanessa Buescher (buzybcrafter@yahoo.com).

CQA Block Of the Month (BOM) quilts

Quilts submitted should have been completed as a result of participating in the BOM project. These don't need musical inspirations as their themes, but definitely should include the **personal statement** about what you learned each month, how you arranged the final quilt, etc. Block of the Month quilts will be collected and coordinated by Lisa Gorski (lisagski@gmail.com).

“Name That Tune” Quilt Challenge

All CQA members are encouraged to participate in this challenge of small SQUARE quilts with a maximum size of 24 x 24 inches. **Each challenge quilt must include a musical symbol.** These creations should help the viewers 'name a tune' or be reminded of something musical. Each quilt needs a 3-inch sleeve and the name of the maker sewn or safety pinned to the back. Include a **personal statement** that references the 'tune'. These quilts will be collected by Lynne Woods (lynnnerwoods@gmail.com).

Quilts Returned to Maker

Quilts will be returned to the maker or their designated representative following the show on Saturday, April 20 between 5 – 6 p.m. Any quilt not collected on that date will be available for pick up at the May 14, 2024 CQA monthly meeting.
