



## Quilt Show Updates

**CQA's Quilt Show "Stitching In Harmony" is Saturday, April 20<sup>th</sup> from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.**

**Tickets are \$15 each and will be available at the March 12<sup>th</sup> and April 9<sup>th</sup> CQA meetings; and from the CQA website.**

**Quilt Entry applications are due March 12. There is a \$25 entry fee (which includes 1 ticket and 10 raffle tickets) for one quilt or \$40 entry fee (which includes 2 tickets and 10 raffle tickets) for two quilts submitted in the general category.**

There is **no entry fee to enter additional quilts in the general category after you have entered the first two.** You may enter as many quilts as you like and we will hang as many as space allows. If you plan to enter additional quilts, please complete an entry form for each and deliver it by March 12; you will be contacted before April 9<sup>th</sup> to advise if space is available so you can deliver your quilt at the April 9<sup>th</sup> meeting.

**The quilt does not need to be finished until the April 9<sup>th</sup> delivery date.** All quilts must be delivered to the April 9<sup>th</sup> CQA membership meeting. Each quilt should be in its own cloth bag; include the name of the maker on the bag; and attach a copy of the entry form to the bag for check-in on April 9<sup>th</sup>.

**"Name That Tune" Challenge Quilts**---must be square and no larger than 24 inches by 24. There is **no entry fee** for this category, but each entry requires a sleeve, label and entry form. All challenge entries must include a musical symbol, such as fabric that includes musical notes or instruments. Contact Lynne Woods (lynnerwoods@gmail.com) for details.

**CQA Block of the Month** --- features quilts made as a result of our BOM programs. Let us know what year the project was planned. There is **no entry fee** for this category. Entries require a sleeve, label and entry form. Contact Lisa Gorski (lisagski@gmail.com) for details.

**CQA Workshops** --- quilts shown should have been made at a CQA guild workshop, include a sleeve, label and entry form. There is **no entry fee** for this category. Contact Vanessa Buescher (busybcrafter@yahoo.com) for details.

**The entry application and guidelines are posted on the CQA website so you can print as many entry forms as you need.**

**Boutique** plans are being coordinated by Jonette Duchai (jon2205@yahoo.com). If you or your small group have items to donate, please contact Jonette to advise what you have and when you can deliver the items. Space is limited so it's possible that not all items will be shown; however, we can sell excess items at the May meeting for a "final, round-up sale".

There are no consignment sales for this Boutique; the proceeds of all sales will directly benefit the guild. However, **if you or your small group have a quilt that you are willing to sell at the show as a donation to benefit the Guild, please contact Cheryl to coordinate details.**
