In this presentation, Kristie will share an overview of the Scrappy Appliqué process from start to finish and end with a trunk show of different examples of projects to inspire quilters to create their own.

In this workshop, you will learn a one of a kind technique called Scrappy Applique™. No two projects EVER look alike because there are lots of creative possibilities that are fun and easy enough for a beginner, but interesting enough for an advanced quilter. Whether you're new to appliqué, or have been doing it for years, this method will teach you some new tips, tricks and techniques that can apply to other projects.

Each person chooses a small or medium pattern from the huge variety of over 250 Scrappy Applique™ patterns. Then you will be use your own fabric scraps and fusibles, to create a one of a kind project.

The entire process is broken into highly detailed steps including fabric selection, fusing, cutting, collaging, and finishing options. Throughout the workshop you will learn insider tips, tricks and techniques to make the process quick, easy and fun.
