

**Camarillo Quilters Association  
Board Meeting Minutes  
April 13, 2026**

The meeting was called to order by co-president Wendy VanLoo at 10:32 AM. There is a quorum.

**Rose Gamboa moved, and Jan Hunter seconded, to approve the Board meeting minutes from the March Board meeting. The motion passed unanimously.**

**Jan Hunter moved, and Rose Gamboa seconded, to approve the March General Meeting Minutes.**

No Secretary report.

Rose Gamboa (**Vice President**) reported that "Meet the Teachers" went well. She will work with Joey Strait about future bookings that might interest CQA members. Next year insurance will cost \$6 per member. The insurance covers the Board for any litigation. Proof of insurance forms will go up to \$20 each. The June 25th SCCQG meeting will be regarding how to do social media for a guild.

Rose Gamboa picked up mail and found a check from Kingdom and the Premier Account statement.

Kathy Antrobus (**Treasurer**) reported she has received two checks for the vendor fair. She cannot access the Bank of America accounts. Joey Strait is working on the transition of CQA's square account to the new bank accounts at Premier America Credit Union.

Wendy VanLoo reported that there will be 8 vendors at the event on April 25 in Simi Valley. CQA will use two cash registers. Each vendor will do their own sales.

Jonal Beck will help with the floor plan. There will also be an Opportunity Quilt from Valley Quilters as well as a bake sale. Wendy will be recruiting volunteers at the meeting tomorrow. Barbara Witman reported that the certificate of insurance was turned into the church. Folks should bring their quilts to show on the morning of the event. Friday night is set-up time, from 6 to 8 pm.

Conejo Valley Quilters has offered to sell some free-standing quilt stands for \$50 each to CQA. The consensus was that CQA does not need them.

Jodie Solorio (**Nominating Committee**) reported that the general membership will vote on the slate of officers at tomorrow's meeting. (See attached.)

Jan Hunter (**Membership**) reported that there were 108 members and 12 guests at the March meeting. Membership renewal begins tomorrow. The current membership is 205.

Jonal Beck (**Facilities**) will send out a message showing all leaders where their tables will be tomorrow at the Freedom Center. The free table will be in a separate room behind the stage.

Joey Strait (**Speaker Contracts**) reported that she is filling the speaker calendar for 2027. Discussion followed regarding Edyta Sitar coming to speak. The consensus was to offer her \$900 for a lecture. She would be a good draw for visitors and new members.

Diane Fussell (**Speaker Hospitality**) spoke with the May speaker. Everything is set for her arrival.

Vanessa Buescher (**Workshops**) reported that there are 10 people who signed up for the April workshop as well as 10 for the May workshop. Joey Strait volunteered to take over for Vanessa while she is gone.

Holly Winston (**Ways & Means**) reported that there will be a regular auction tomorrow.

Tedi Patterson (**Block of the Month**) reported the April Block-of-the-Month has California poppies. The link is available for posting. The drawing for participants will be in July. There will be 3 prizes at \$60 each. Tedi met with Jodie to start the transition to Jodie's leadership.

Jonal Beck (**Facilities**) reported that she has turned in the floor plan for tomorrow's meeting.
